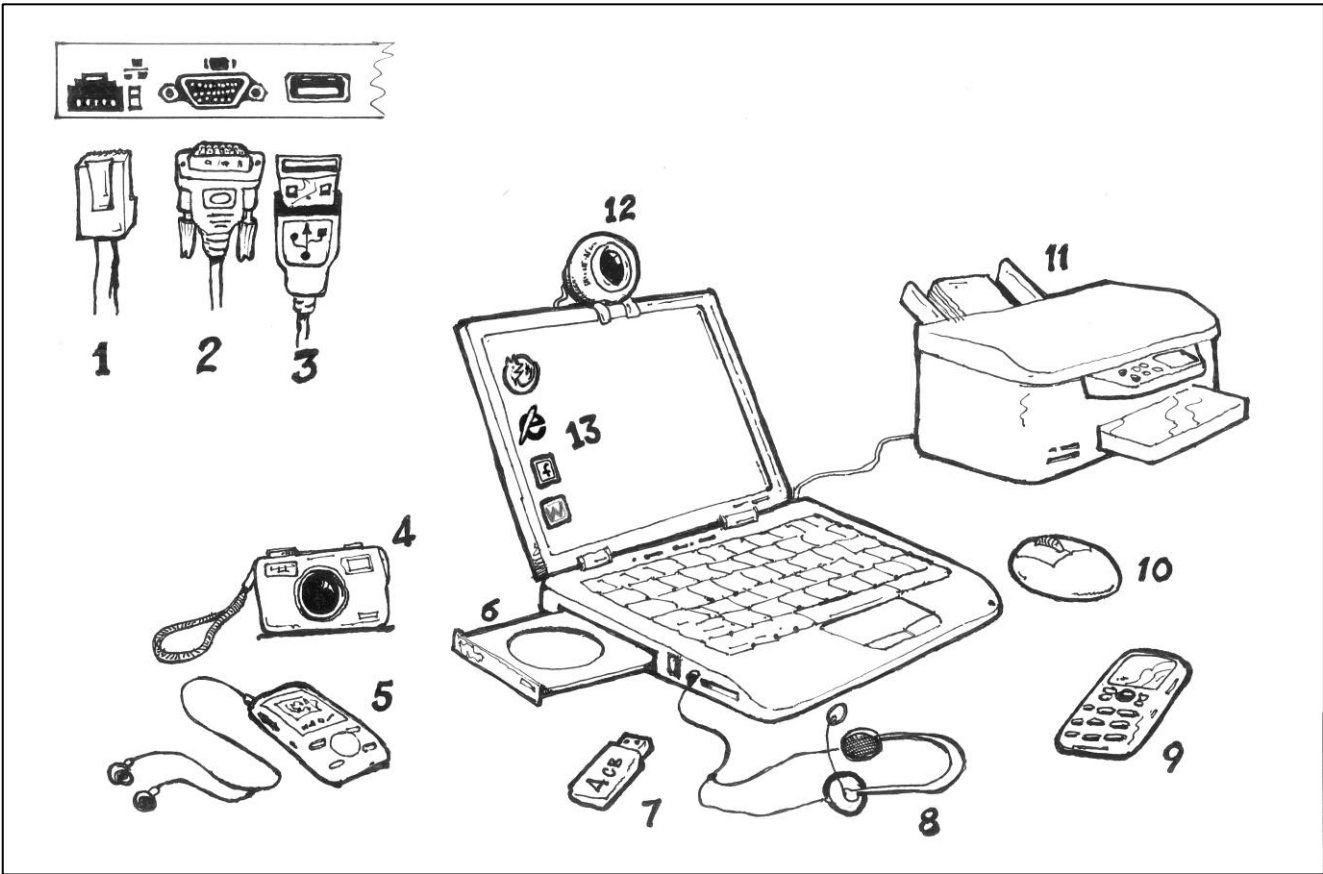

In a recent online survey by MSN, results revealed that 64% of under-18 year olds in the UK have been contacted by someone they don't know online, and worryingly, over one third responded.

February saw the launch of the UK Click Clever, Click Safe, digital safety code – 'Zip It, Block It, Flag It'.

## Internet safety tips

To help make the online world a safer place for young people share these simple safety rules with your Beavers.

- When chatting to people online, try not to give out any personal information about yourself such as your name, address, phone number or school
- Only add people to your online sites who are your friends in the real world
- Never open an email from someone you don't know, always delete it in case it contains a virus
- Treat people online with the same respect and

consideration as you would in the real world. Never write anything that might hurt or upset someone

- It's easy for people to lie when they're chatting over the internet, you should try not to meet up with someone that you have met online. If you do decide to go make sure you take an adult you trust and meet in a public place
- If you are ever worried about anything you see on the internet talk to an adult you trust such as your leader, parent or teacher
