What animal is represented on the sculpture for the Shipwright's Way near where the footpath from West Liss to the Liss Forest railway crossing meets the Riverside Walk?	
To whom is the memorial on Longmoor, relating to a WW2 air crash where the loss of life was the result of avoiding the village as the aircraft was going down? Hint – it is near the main Forest Road entrance: after entering Longmoor, after about 50 M bear left up the hill, through the trees until you can walk along a ridge of a small hill.	
What is written on the dark blue board over the front entrance of the Temple Inn, Liss Forest?	
When is the last weekday collection from the post box by the Old Post Office, Liss Forest?	
At the Liss Pavilion there is a defibrillator. The yellow box has 4 blue circle icons on the left hand side – what is the third icon?	
At the corner of Station Road and Farnham Road there is a post box under the Bluebell Inn sign – what time is the post collected on a Wednesday?

<p>On the peak of the roof at The Triangle Centre Liss, how many points are on the ironwork?</p>	
<p>At St Peters Vets, on Mill Road Liss, what time are the weekly Consultation slots on the notice board?</p>
